CONSTITUTION

PREAMBLE

We, the members of the BEANTOWN SOFTBALL LEAGUE, in order to provide a formal structure for the continuation of a softball league in the Greater Boston area free from discrimination on the basis of race, religion, creed, sex, ability, or sexual orientation; in order to provide for the maximum participation in organized softball by the Greater Boston gay community in an atmosphere of fellowship and friendly competition; and, in order to formalize our objectives; hereby adopt this our CONSTITUTION.
