FCHC Donation: At the January meeting it was decided to donate all profits from Series '91 to the construction of the "Our Names" wall at the Fenway Community Health Center. By funding a major portion of the construction costs it enables the FCHC to direct existing resources to providing low cost and free care to the many patients who depend on the FCHC.
